Ministerial Assignment

To : Rear Admiral (Retired) Josaia Voreqe Bainimarama
Prime Minister and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I assigned to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister and Minister for iTaukei Affairs, Sugar Industry and Foreign Affairs with effect from 22 November 2018, the responsibility for the conduct of Government businesses, divisions and written laws specified in Legal Notice No. 87 of 2018;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as the Prime Minister of the Republic of Fiji under section 92(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Fiji, I hereby revoke with effect from 23 January 2019, all assignments and responsibilities under Legal Notice No. 87 of 2018, and with effect from the same day assign to myself in my capacity as the Prime Minister and Minister for iTaukei Affairs and Sugar Industry the responsibility for the conduct of the following Government businesses, divisions and written laws (subject to the provisions of any other written law) —
