1.0 Applications are invited from Fiji citizens residing permanently in Fiji, who have passed or are currently doing FSLC/FSFE or equivalent programs, or are studying privately at Tertiary Institutions, for the pre-service MEA Scholarship tenable in 2007 at the institutions and for the courses listed below. Applicants must:

- Be members of Communities other than Fijians or Rotumans
- Be unemployed and fully supported by parents or legal guardians whose combined gross annual income does not exceed \$10,000.00; this may vary for the Minority Communities
- Not hold another Government Scholarship
