Licensing of VoIP Service Providers

- ❑ Licensing of VoIP service providers administered under the appropriate provisions in the Posts and Telecommunications Decree 1989. – principally s7 of the Decree “Power to License Systems”
- ❑ Promote and encourage semblance of orderliness from inception of provision of VoIP service.

Procedure

- Register your interest with the Ministry by writing to –

Requirements

- ❑ Required to complete LA1 Form and respond to list in its Appendix
- ❑ Annual licence fee \$2000 plus VAT (this will change when licence fee review is effected in 2008)
- ❑ Additional fees are levied for use of radio frequency (and number fee levy will become effective in 2008)

Licence Processing

- ❑ As a general rule, once all necessary details are provided, licence should be issued within 30 days
