

[LEGAL NOTICE NO. 12]

LAND TRANSPORT ACT 1998

Land Transport (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2018

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 113 of the Land Transport Act 1998, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Land Transport (Public Service Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2018.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on 1 January 2018.

(3) In these Regulations, the Land Transport (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations 2000 is referred to as the “Principal Regulations”.

Regulation 5A amended

2. Regulation 5A(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (b) of the definition of “application cessation date” by deleting “21” and substituting “14”.

Regulation 5C amended

3. Regulation 5C of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “21” and substituting “14”.

Regulation 5F amended

4. Regulation 5F of the Principal Regulations is amended by—

- (a) in subregulation (1), deleting “21” and substituting “14”; and
- (b) in subregulation (3), deleting “42” and substituting “35”.

Regulation 11A amended

5. Regulation 11A(5) of the Principal Regulations is amended by—

- (a) in paragraph (a), deleting “and”;
- (b) in paragraph (b), deleting “.” and substituting “; and”; and
- (c) inserting after paragraph (b), the following new paragraph—
 - “(c) regulation 4(1) does not apply to transfers conducted under the circumstances listed in subregulation (2).”

Regulation 18A amended

6. Regulation 18A(6) of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (d) and substituting the following—

“(d) a rural service licence issued before 1 January 2018 is deemed to be either—

- (i) a minibus permit, if the rural service licence was issued in respect of a vehicle that is similar in construction to a minibus; or
- (ii) a road permit in respect of a carrier licence, if the rural service licence was issued in respect of a vehicle that is not similar in construction to a minibus; and”.

LITTER ACT 2008

**Litter Offence (Fixed Penalty Notice)
Regulations 2018**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 22(2) and 27 of the Litter Act 2008, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Litter Offence (Fixed Penalty Notice) Regulations 2018.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on the date the Litter Act 2008 came into force.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, “Act” means the Litter Act 2008.

(2) In these Regulations, words and phrases have the same meaning as under the Act unless the context otherwise requires.

Fixed penalty notice

3.—(1) A fixed penalty notice to be served under section 22(1) of the Act is to be in the form prescribed in the Schedule.

(2) Nothing in subregulation (1) affects the validity of a fixed penalty notice issued prior to the commencement of these Regulations and any such fine is deemed to be paid or payable in accordance with the law applicable at the time such fixed penalty notice was issued.

Repeal

4. The Litter Offence (Prescribed Notice) Regulations 1991 and the Litter (Prescribed Form) Regulations 1997 are revoked.
