

## URGENT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR SOCIAL WELFARE RECIPIENTS CASHING AT POST OFFICES

The Ministry of Women, Children and Social Protection is phasing out the manual voucher payment process with effect from January 2024 where there will be a slight change to direct cash payment at Post Offices.

The Ministry wishes to inform Social Welfare recipients on the Family Assistance, Care and Protection, Social Pension and Disability Allowance Scheme who collect their monthly allowance from either postal agencies or post offices. Please note the changes for the month of January and onwards:

**Criteria A:** CASH VOUCHER RECIPIENTS THAT WILL STILL <u>CONTINUE TO BE ON VOUCHERS</u> ARE THOSE CASHING AT THE FOLLOWING POSTAL AGENCIES OR POST OFFICES.
